# Traffic adjustments at Kronenburg and Zonnestein

Dear residents, business owners,

The Kronenburg and Zonnestein stops will be reopened in the spring of 2020. In preparation of that, VITAL will start changing the local traffic situation from late January: connecting new roads to existing ones. Firstly at Kronenburg, and then at Zonnestein. With this letter, I would like to inform you about these works, how they may affect you, and invite you to an information evening.

## **Information evening Thursday 23 January**

To start with the latter: you are warmly invited to our information evening about all the planned work, up to and including the spring of 2020, and the temporary traffic adjustments at Kronenburg and Zonnestein. Where and when? Thursday evening 23 January between 18.30 and 21.00 hours at the Amstelveen InZicht centre, Stadsplein 103, second floor, above the library. This will be a walk-in evening, combined with short presentations at 19.00, 19.30, 20.00 and 20.30 hours. There is no need to register.

#### Kronenburg open again on Monday 9 March, Zonnestein on Monday 4 May

Where at the moment VITAL is still completing the building work, the adjustments of the traffic situation will kick off during the night of Sunday 26 into Monday 27 January. The Kronenburg intersection will be fully reopened for all traffic on Monday 9 March. From that same date, the new Kronenburg stop will be open for public transport customers. As soon as that happens, the crossing for pedestrians and cyclists at Biesbosch and the temporary Biesbosch stop will be removed. The Zonnestein intersection and stop will be reopened on Monday 4 May.

To keep the traffic flowing, the adjustments at Kronenburg and Zonnestein cannot be done at the same time. The building work causes a large number of changing traffic situations and – regrettably – a lot of inconvenience for road users. Please check the attached leaflet for more information.

## Temporary minibus for pedestrians at Zonnestein

As said, when on Monday 9 March the Kronenburg stop will be reopened, the Biesbosch stop and the accompanying crossing for pedestrians and cyclists will no longer be operational. Up until the reopening

of the Zonnestein stop on Monday 4 May, public transport customers can use the Kronenburg and Onderuit stops. For pedestrians, a temporary minibus will be introduced at Zonnestein. This little bus will drive between Zonnestein and the Kostverlorenhof shopping centre. More information will soon be available on our website.

#### What does all this mean for you in other ways?

• The work will take place during regular hours, Monday to Saturday between 7.00 and 19.00 hours, except for the days mentioned below, when the work will continue during the night:

# At Kronenburg:

- o between Monday 20 and Saturday 25 January
- o between Sunday 26 January and Monday 3 February
- between Saturday 15 and Monday 17 February
- o between Saturday 14 and Monday 16 March

## At Zonnestein:

- o between Saturday 14 and Monday 16 March
- o between Saturday 4 and Monday 6 April
- between Saturday 18 and Monday 20 April
- The work will cause inconvenience in terms of noise, particularly during the transport of prefab components, asphalt milling, compressing soil and road foundations and laying asphalt, and the large amount of work traffic.
- Road users (including bus 55) will be affected because of the changing traffic situations and possibly by work traffic. VITAL will deploy traffic wardens where necessary.
- During the early morning hours, as well as the late afternoons and early evenings, extra lighting may be necessary.
- We do not expect specific inconvenience in terms of dust and dirt. If it occurs after all, VITAL will see to the clean-up of the road.
- Emergency services will always have free passage.
